They are offered for an individual soul. Gregorian Masses take their name from Saint Gregory the Great, who was sovereign Pontiff from 590 to 604. St. In his Dialogues, he tells us that he had Masses on thirty consecutive days offered for the repose of the soul of Justus, a monk who had died in the convent of St. Andrew in Rome. At the end of the thirtieth Mass, the deceased appeared to one of his fellow monks and announced that he had been delivered from the flames of Purgatory.
