SUNG MASS W/ PROCESSION FRIDAY IN HONOR OF OUR LADY FOR FEAST OF CANDLEMASS

Please note that the evening Mass this Friday (Feb 2nd) will be a Sung Mass at **7:00pm** (not 6pm) for the Feast of Candlemass. Blessing of Candles and Procession to take place before Mass. You may bring candles to be blessed and place them in the front of the church as usual.

MEDITATION FOR THE FEAST OF THE PURIFICATION

In the old law a woman bearing a child was unclean because she bore a child whom she conceived in original sin. The law of Moses directed that she be kept away from the temple, and be held, as it were, "unclean" for forty days, until she was purified by the prescribed rite. But the Blessed Virgin, pure and spotless, free from all sin, incurred no such defilement, and therefore was not bound by the law of purification. Yet, in her zeal for humility, in order to make herself like other women who bear children, that she might not give scandal in seeming to be singular, and that she might conceal her virginity and her conception by the Holy Ghost, the Blessed Virgin was willing to be purified, even as Christ, for similar reasons, was willing to be circumcised.

The Blessed Virgin, holding Christ in her hands, on bended knee, offered Him to God with the greatest reverence and devotion, saying, "Behold, O Eternal Father, this is Thy Son whom Thou hast wished to take flesh from me for the salvation of men. To Thee I render Him, and to Thee I offer Him entirely, that Thou mayest do with Him and with me as it shall please Thee, and by Him mayest redeem the world." So saying, she presented Him to the priest as to the representative of God; and then she redeemed Him with five shekels, as the law prescribed.
