At first, perhaps, one may be inclined to cry out incredulously: "How can God need MY help for anything whatsoever? Is He not omnipotent? Is it not derogatory to His power and majesty to speak of Him as needing our help to accomplish His purpose?"

Yes, God is omnipotent, but, by His own free choice, He has brought about a state of things in which He needs OUR help and OUR co-operation so urgently and essentially that, if we fail Him, if we refuse our help (as we may) the work will not be done, and His plans to that extent frustrated. If you ask: "How can this be?" the answer is: "God has bestowed upon man the full and unhindered exercise of that marvelous faculty. It is our FREE service that God wishes to have.

He could leave us no choice but to love Him, but then our love would not be the result of our own free will. So that it is true to say that each of us, weak and wretched though we be, has in his keeping a gift which God wants, which we can refuse to give Him if we choose, and which, if we refuse, God cannot force us to bestow upon Him – namely, the gift of our free acts of love and service."

Those acts constitute an empire over which you are absolute ruler. God will assist you by His Grace. He will give you all necessary interior helps and encouragement, but He leaves your will free. YOU must choose. He will not choose for you.

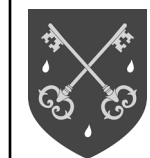
