FRIDAYS FOR LIFE AUGUST & SEPTEMBER: The U.S. Bishops request that Catholics pray a Novena of Nine Fridays and fast asking God for the overturning of the Roe vs Wade decision legalizing abortion: **Friday, August 3, 2018 to Friday, September 28, 2018.** The weekly Call to Prayer will be adapted as a nine-week Novena for the Legal Protection of Human Life. **In addition to the current invitation to fast on Fridays, participants are encouraged to pray one *Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be* for the intention of the novena.**

E - Entrance Hymn | A - Asperges me (Sundays - Outside Easter time)

V - Vidi aquam (Sundays - Easter time) | O - Ordinary (i.e. Kyrie, Gloria etc)

C - Credo | M - Marian antiphon | B - Benediction | R - Recessional Hymn

The top row always shows the name of the Mass (and page # in SEC Missal & Hymnal). Numbers are in order as the Mass goes (left to right and top to bottom). All numbers refer to the St Edmund Campanion Missal & Hymnal. All other information will be spelled out if needed.

The congregation is encouraged to sing the Entrance and Recessional Hymns, Mass Ordinary (if not polyphony), Credo and Marian antiphon. Chant Kyrie and Gloria are sung in responsorial form (i.e., the men's schola sings one verse and the whole congregation sings the next verse, and so on). Occasionally there are handout sheets for Entrance or Recessional Hymns as well as for special occasions (Corpus Christi, Te Deum, May Crowning etc.) when the particular hymn/music is not in the parish hymnal.

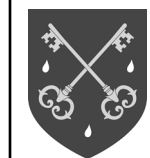
