VISITING A CEMETERY—NOVEMBER 1-8: A plenary indulgence may be gained for a soul in Purgatory each day during the “octave of the Holy Souls”, November 1-8, by visiting a cemetery and praying devoutly for the Faithful departed.

In order to obtain it, the faithful must, in addition to being in the state of grace: —have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin; —have sacramentally confessed their sins; —receive the Holy Eucharist; —pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff. These things are to be carried out within several days (about 20) before or after the indulgenced act is performed. Prayer for the Pope's intentions is left to the choice of the faithful, but an Our Father and a Hail Mary are suggested. One Confession suffices for several plenary indulgences, but a separate Holy Communion and a separate prayer for the Holy Father's intentions are required for each plenary indulgence.
