ARCHBISHOP'S 5 YEAR CAPITAL CAMPAIGN: The Archdiocese is in the midst of a 65 million dollar 5 year capital campaign - One Faith, One Family, One Future.

Our parish's target is \$277,500.00 spread over 5 years. This represents 1 year of average income minus a 25% "back to parish" rebate which we have elected to forfeit (making our target smaller).

Pledge cards and envelopes for direct giving to the Archdiocese will be available Sunday, May 12.

In agreement with the Archbishop, we have elected to forgo home visitation by fundraising teams, but, however, any annual shortfall in our pledge obligation will be paid by the parish directly. Our annual obligation is \$55,500. If for any reason you do not wish to give directly, please consider increasing your general parish giving so that we can make our target.

Given that the Archdiocese has paid hundreds of thousands of dollars defending our rights in court, it is only right that we do what we can.

Principle uses for the campaign monies are:

- Supporting Parishes, Schools, and Evangelization: \$22 million
- Honoring and Caring for Retired Priests: \$17 million
- Strengthening Villa St. Francis Skilled Nursing Facility: \$10 million
- Improving Savior Pastoral Center: \$10 million

FR. LEONARD GOFFINE ON TODAY'S GOSPEL:

Why did our Savior tell His disciples of their future joys and sufferings?

That they might the more easily bear the sufferings that were to come, because we can be prepared for sufferings which we know are pending; because He knew that their sufferings would be only slight and momentary in comparison with the everlasting joy which awaited them, like the pains of a woman in giving birth to a child which are great indeed, but short, and soon forgotten by the mother in joy at the birth of the child. "Tell me" says St. Chrysostom, "if you were elected king but were obliged to spend the night preceding your entrance into your capital city where you were to be crowned, if you were compelled to pass that night in much discomfort in a stable, would you not joyfully endure it in the expectation of your kingdom? And why should not we, in this valley of tears, willingly live through adversities, in expectation of one day obtaining the kingdom of heaven?"
