BISHOP RICHARD RYAN ON THE FEAST OF THE SACRED HEART (1939): In all the feasts of the Church in honour of Jesus Christ, the ultimate end and object is to honour the Person of the Eternal Word, God the Son. Besides this end common to all the feasts, each feast or devotion has an object peculiar to itself. In devotion to the Blessed Sacrament, we adore Jesus Christ hidden beneath the sacramental veils; in devotion to the Precious Blood, we adore that life-giving stream which washes away the sins of the world. And so, too, in devotion to the Sacred Heart of Our Lord, the direct object of this devotion is the material Heart of Jesus Christ, the Heart of Flesh, the real and living Heart of our Saviour, the Heart which beat in His bosom at the moment of the Incarnation, the physical Heart which bled for us on Calvary's hill and is now glorified in heaven—the Heart ever inseparably united to the Person of the Eternal Word. We do not in our devotion separate the Heart from the Body or the Body from the Person of God the Son. We think of that Heart as beating in his breast, as vivified by His human soul and owned by a Divine Person, as that Divine Person's own Heart, and as therefore to be adored.

What then are we to think of the picture and image of the Sacred Heart? It is true that Our Divine Lord declared to St. Margaret Mary that He took a special pleasure in the honour paid to the image of His Heart and that He would even bless the homes where that image was honoured and venerated. Still, the Mass and the Feast were instituted to honour, not the image or the picture, but His Sacred Heart, which is now in heaven inseparably united to His Divine Person. There is no doubt that the image or figure of the Divine Heart of Jesus has a peculiar power of stirring up in our hearts the duty of gratitude and, above all, of reparation, which are the fruits of this devotion; but we must never forget that all this leads us to centre our thoughts and affections on Jesus Christ. We do not separate in our devotion the Heart from the Divine Person. The Heart of Jesus is adorable in Itself—not on account of Itself, but as forming one whole with God.

An Act of Adoration: Sweet Jesus, adorable Saviour, hidden in the Sacrament of Thy love, I adore Thee. Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, I consecrate to Thee all the faculties of my soul and all the powers of my body. I wish to endeavour to know and love Thee ever more and more. I consecrate to Thee all the moments of my life in a spirit of adoration before Thy royal Presence; in thanksgiving for this incomparable gift, in reparation for my past indifference, and to implore that my prayers to Thee may ascend purified and fruitful to the throne of God's mercy.
