**BISHOP RICHARD RYAN, C.M., ON PENTECOST:** What was the effect of the Holy Ghost in the souls of the Apostles on Pentecost day? He worked a twofold miracle: an internal miracle and an external miracle. An internal miracle—all their faculties were enriched with the gifts of God. They understood without difficulty all the ancient prophecies and sacred books. As for their hearts, divine love so penetrated them that they were prepared to obey the inspirations of the Holy Spirit. In one word, the Holy Ghost changed them into new men.

The proof of this internal change was the external miracle in their conduct. See these twelve Galileans, these uneducated fishermen, speaking and writing with an eloquence and a wisdom that confound their enemies, applying with the utmost precision the most difficult passages of the sacred books, showing most clearly that they did not speak of themselves.

What shall we say of their courage and zeal for the glory of God? As soon as these men, hitherto so timid, have received the Holy Ghost, they open the doors of the cenacle which they had kept so carefully closed; they appear in the Temple, on public squares, and preach Jesus Christ in the midst of the very nation which had crucified Him. A short time before, the boldest of these Apostles thrice denied his Master at the voice of a maid-servant. Now that same Apostle stands up and in inspired language tells these men of Israel to do penance and be baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ for the remission of their sins, and they shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. They were obedient to this word and to the graces which accompanied it, and three thousand were converted and received baptism.

We can see how that Church has existed and still exists and flourishes in spite of all the opposition and persecutions it has encountered. No human organization could have lived through it all. She is a divine institution and she is adorned with those gifts and graces whose author and giver is the Holy Ghost.

**CONSECRATION TO THE HOLY GHOST:** O Holy Spirit, divine Spirit of light and love, to Thee I consecrate my understanding, my heart, my will, my whole being for time and eternity.

May my understanding be ever submissive to Thy divine inspirations and to the teaching of the Holy Catholic Church of which Thou are the infallible guide; may my heart be ever inflamed with love of God and of neighbor; may my will be ever conformed to the divine will and may my whole life be a faithful imitation of the life and virtues of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, to whom, with the Father and with Thee, O Holy Spirit, be honor and glory forever. Amen.
