**BISHOP RICHARD RYAN ON THE REAL PRESENCE (1939):** It is true that when the priest bows down at the solemn moment of Consecration, repeating the same words that Christ used at the Last Supper—"This is My Body," "This is My Blood"—the great miracle of the Last Supper is again accomplished. These mystic words bring the King of Heaven into the lowliest church, not merely as He is in all creation, but with special and peculiar Presence; really and truly there in His Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity, as He is at this moment in heaven with the elect. It is also true that there is nothing whatsoever in the consecrated bread or wine even to suggest to our senses the Real Presence of our Divine Lord; yet we are more certain of His Presence there than if we actually saw Him with the eyes of our body. Where do we get this certainty? From His Word and the teaching of His Church. God can do all things, but there is one thing that He cannot do, and that is deceive us. Our senses may sometimes deceive us, but the Word of God and His infallible Church never can deceive us. Let us reflect that the abiding Presence of our Divine Lord amongst us is to be realized by a perpetual exercise of faith—that faith which relies on God and abandons itself to Him. When you kneel down at Mass and devoutly strike your breast at the moment of Consecration, or when you approach the altar rail, it is though you said in so many words, "Great God, what I rely upon is not the evidence of my senses, but Thy Word. Because Thou hast said it, I firmly believe that to this appearance of bread Thine Omnipotence hast united the Presence of Jesus Christ, the God-Man. I cannot understand, but I trust. From You nature received her laws, and You, the great Almighty God, can transcend these laws whenever you choose."

We may feel inclined to ask why there is so little in the Mystery of Faith that is calculated to impress the minds of men; but we know the same question might have been asked beside the crib by the shepherds who came to adore the new-born Babe, and it might have been asked before the Cross. We also know that Christ all His life willed to impress us by His humility and self-annihilation, and these are just what this Most Holy Sacrament reveals to us. He hides His glory and majesty in the Blessed Sacrament. He does more—He hides His human nature. He is a hidden God. We know He is there, but we know it by faith, and by faith alone. The Church and her faithful children know Jesus Christ in His hidden and cloistered life. They have gazed on His sacred countenance for over nineteen hundred years, and they can never mistake His identity.
