This disastrous truth was openly announced to Him shortly after His Birth: "Behold, this Child is set up for the ruin as well as for the resurrection of many in Israel." How little men think of the Passion! No wonder that the sad complaint, "What use is there in My Blood?" is put on the lips of Him Who shed all His Blood for men. The all-important question for us is: "Will the Precious Blood be shed for us in vain?" Our Lord would have all men to be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth. But He does not force man's free will. He pleads, but does not compel. Man's cooperation is necessary for his salvation. We all hope for mercy from His Redeeming Blood, but we must take the means to make that hope effective for our salvation. As Our Lord poured out the last drop of His Blood on Calvary, what a vision met his gaze! Every soul that would not profit by His Blood stood out clearly and distinctly before Him. Let us ask ourselves whether we are in that number. Let us ask Him that His Blood may not have been shed in vain. Let us keep our souls signed and sealed by It. It will keep us from our mortal enemy, sin. It will console our dying moments. It will plead forgiveness for sins of frailty and weakness. It will be our sure and safe passport to our homeland beyond the stars.

Prayer: O Almighty and Everlasting God, Who hast appointed Thine only begotten Son to be the Redeemer of the world, and hast been pleased to be reconciled unto us by His Blood, grant us, we beseech Thee, so to venerate with solemn worship the Price of our redemption, and to be on earth so defended by Its power from the evils of this present life, that we may rejoice with perpetual fruits in heaven. Through the same Jesus Christ Our Lord. Amen.
