**BISHOP RICHARD RYAN ON THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY (1939):**

If this Feast is one of joy and gladness for Mary, it is no less so for us. Her entrance into heaven is a triumph for the whole human race. Our Blessed Lord entered heaven on the day of His Ascension, the first human Conqueror that entered there; but He was God also. Mary entered heaven, the first purely human being that ever passed its gates. It is this fact that makes her Assumption so joyful. The great promise of Christianity, the dearest hope of Christians was fulfilled and confirmed.

Because we inherit a nature tainted by the corruption of sin, our bodies will one day moulder into the dust from which they have been formed. But this state of humiliation will not always last. Faith assures us, not only that the bodies which have perished will again rise to life, but if we die in the friendship of God, our bodies shall arise glorious and incorruptible. "It is sown in dishonor; it shall rise in glory. It is sown in weakness; it shall rise in power." If then, we are faithful to God, imitating the virtues of Mary, God shall do for us in time what He anticipated in the case of His Blessed Mother, and so we shall share in the victory and glory of Mary.

The prayers of the Virgin Mother while she lived here on earth were certainly of great efficacy. Now, raised to that state of ineffable bliss, seated near the throne of mercy, knowing more clearly than ever the dangers by which we are surrounded, her Mother's heart filled with a compassion even greater than when here on earth, looking into the Face of her Divine Son, there is nothing too great for her to ask or for Him to grant. Let us take occasion from this great Feast of Our Lady to renew once again our devotion to her and our confidence in her intercession with her Divine Son. Let us celebrate all her feasts in such a way that the memory of them may hallow our deathbeds and make them peaceful and happy.
