What a beautiful sight it is to see husband and wife and children together, blending their voices in the recitation of the Rosary, calling on their common Father to supply all their needs of soul and body, and beseeching His Blessed Mother to pray for them now and at the hour of their death! Such homes may not be rich in worldly treasures, they may even feel the pinch of poverty, but they are rich in God's blessing, and something of the peace and joy that filled the Holy Home of Nazareth comes upon the hearts of parents and children.
