The Penitential Season of Advent

As the great feast of Christmas draws near, our Mother the Church is not without grave anxiety. She foresees that many of her children will show themselves indifferent as were the people of Bethlehem on the day of Our Lord's first coming. Is it not written of them: "His own received Him not...there was no room for them?" To avert such a calamity, she does not cease to call upon all to do penance. From the pulpits, we hear the voice of St. Paul, Isaias, John the Baptist, and finally, of Christ Himself: "It is now the hour for us to rise from sleep." To induce us to bring forth fruits worthy of penance, she puts before us, at the very beginning of Advent, the thought of the Last Judgment.

Mindful of the state of the Church and our own souls, each is highly encouraged to undertake some penance this Advent.
