### CURRENT LAWS OF FASTING AND ABSTINENCE FOR LENT

- **FASTING**
  - Law binds those from age 18-58
  - One full meal is permitted with two smaller meals which together are less than a full meal
  - Days of fasting are Ash Wednesday, February 26, 2020, and Good Friday, April 10, 2020
- **ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT**
  - Law binds those age 14 and older
  - Days of Abstinence are Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent
