**REFLECTIONS ON THE FEAST OF ALL SAINTS BY BISHOP RICHARD RYAN (1939):**

We are in danger of considering holiness as the prerogative of a few rather than the calling of all. Some people will say, "I have no ambition to be a saint. I shall be quite content to be saved," just as if these two things were not identical. In the beginning of the Church all follower of Christ were called saints. They were not expected to raise the dead to life or to perform other wonderful works, but they were expected to walk worthy of their title and the calling which it implied. We should, therefore, start from this principle, that the duty of holiness is the ordinary duty of every Christian. We shall see that a man may be as well a saint at the counter or in the workshop as at the altar, and at home as in a monastery. Sanctity is not a profession, but a duty, not a privilege but an obligation and it is possible to attain it through the most ordinary means. Every action of the day may be an instrument of sanctification when performed with purity of intention, conformity to the holy Will of God and by making His glory and obedience to His law the great objects and ends of all that we do.
