VALUE THEM BOTH AMENDMENT: We celebrate the decision of the US Supreme Court to overturn *Roe v. Wade*, but in Kansas, where the Kansas Supreme Court has declared that a right to elective abortion is found in the state constitution, nothing has changed. In fact, Kansas is now a place to come for abortion for those whose states have effectively outlawed it. The Value them Both Amendment to the Kansas Constitution, on the election ballot on August 2, declares that there is not a right to abortion in Kansas, and that laws may be passed in Kansas against abortion.

IF the Value them Both amendment is NOT passed, all current laws limiting abortions in Kansas are at risk of being struck down.

IF the Value them Both amendment IS passed, all of the current laws can remain, Kansas legislators can pass new laws restricting abortions, and Kansans will have the ability to outlaw the barbarism completely.
