### **CURRENT LAWS OF FASTING AND ABSTINENCE FOR LENT**

#### • **FASTING**

- Law binds those from age 18-59
- One full meal permitted with two smaller meals which together are less than a full meal. No food may be taken between meals.
- Days of fasting are Ash Wednesday, February 22, and Good Friday, April 7.

#### • **ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT**

- Law binds those age 14 and older
- Days of Abstinence are Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent

**40 DAYS FOR LIFE:** 40 Days for Life will be resuming in just a few weeks. St. Rose has again agreed to cover two Fridays in March. Please see the sign-up sheets in the vestibule for the hours that need to be covered for this most important event for life and in your charity take an hour of your time to be a witness for these innocent babies' lives.
