**A MEDITATION BY BISHOP CHALLONER FOR LOW SUNDAY:**

Consider that by baptism we are incorporated in Christ and made living members of His mystical body, which is His church; we are made Christians, brethren of Christ, and temples of His Holy Spirit; we who before 'were not His people, are now the people of God,' 1 Pet. ii. 10, 'a chosen generation, a kingly priesthood, a holy nation, a purchased people, called out of darkness into the admirable light of Christ,' v. 9. We are dedicated, sanctified, and consecrated to God by this sacrament, to be irrevocably His, eternally devoted to His divine love. O happy dedication! O my soul, how little hast thou hitherto reflected on these truths! How little hast thou considered the dignity conferred upon thee in baptism! O remember, that what is once dedicated to God ought to remain always His, and that it is a sacrilege to profane or violate what is once consecrated to Him. See then how pure and holy thy whole life ought to be, in consequence of thy being dedicated to God in baptism.
