KNOX BIBLE: Beginning about a month ago, for the repetition of the Epistle and Gospel on Sundays we have been using the English translation of the Bible produced by the great English scholar and author, Msgr. Ronald Knox. This work was completed in the 1940s and was widely hailed. The Knox Bible is firmly rooted in the text of the Vulgate, the Latin Bible that was the Catholic Church's official bible for nearly 1,600 years; and yet Knox was careful to cross check his translation against the Hebrew and Greek texts. His three aims were: accuracy, intelligibility, and readability. He was loyal to these principles without sacrificing the rhetorical power of the original and while deliberately keeping a few of the well loved archaisms in the text. He preferred lucidity to poetry, but as one of the finest literary craftsmen of 20th century England he avoided falling into banality. Pope Pius XII, in a note that he sent to Msgr. Knox shortly before Knox died, called his translation "a praiseworthy achievement ... a monument of many years of patient study and toil." Archbishop Fulton Sheen used the Knox Bible for biblical quotations in his books.
