FROM BLESSED ILDEFONSO SCHUSTER ON THE GOSPEL FOR CORPUS CHRISTI (1930): In the Gospel for today, taken from St John (6: 56-59) we have the words in which our Lord explained to the inhabitants of Capharnaum the spiritual effects of the eucharistic food. As the Father from all eternity engenders the Son from His own substance in the splendour of His sanctity, and shares with Him His own life, so Jesus in the Eucharist transforms the soul into Himself, and by means of his grace endues it with his own life. The devout soul then lives and yet does not live, in the same manner as Jesus in the Eucharist immolates himself as the victim and yet lives in glory. The soul no longer lives to itself, because with Christ it dies to the old Adam; but at the same time this mystical death does not in any way deprive it of its desire to live, since it lives in Christ by a life which is entirely holy and worthy of God. This was the experience of St Paul when he wrote: "I live, but it is no longer I who live, but Christ Who liveth in me."
