### **BISHOP RICHARD RYAN ON FATHERS AND THE FOURTH COMMANDMENT (1939):**

Honor thy father. The father is out all day long earning his bread in the factory or workshop, or in the higher callings of literature, science, or art. When early or long hours of hard work press upon him, it is his best reward to be welcomed back by those to whom he is more than all the world beside. Honor thy father. He it is who provided for you in the days of helpless infancy. He it is who labors and toils for you that you may be fitted to battle through life and gain a position in society. He it is who provided for your education; your clothing, even, is the fruit of hard and toilsome labor. Many a drop of perspiration, many an anxious day, many a sleepless night have these earnings cost him. He denied himself many a pleasure. He fights against sickness, even against old age, to earn the price of your support. It is his constant fear that he may be cut off before he has provided for them the means of subsistence.

Listen to the teaching of the Wise Man in Sacred Scripture, and see by what promises this doctrine is supported. “He who honoureth his father shall have joy in his own children and in the day of his prayer he shall be heard. He that honoureth his father shall enjoy a long life: and he that obeyeth the father shall be a comfort to his mother. Glory not in the dishonour of thy father, for his shame is no glory to thee. Son, support the old age of thy father, and grieve him not in his life, and if his understanding fail have patience with him and despise him not when thou art in thy strength, for the relieving of thy father shall not be forgotten.” (Ecclus. 3)
