BISHOP RICHARD RYAN ON THE ENCOUNTER OF OUR LORD AND ST. MARY MAGDALENE AT THE BANQUET OF SIMON THE PHARISEE: No sin, naturally speaking, could have been more repulsive to the most pure heart of Christ than that of the sinner at His feet; yet, while the faces of the Pharisees are hardened with contemptuous disgust, His shines with the beauty of Divine mercy. Their code of laws would permit no pity for one who had fallen as Mary Magdalene had. They did not know, as He knew, the struggle going on in the soul of that rescued sinner kneeling at His feet, striving to burst asunder the chains of passion and sin. To forgive sins is the privilege of God alone; and so, looking upon the kneeling form of one who now loved Him much, and who would love Him still more in the years to come, He poured into her sin-weary soul the flood of Divine grace that was to make her one of His greatest saints “Thy sins are forgiven.” “Thy faith hath saved thee; go in peace.” She is done with sin. Her whole sinful past is washed away. She is no longer the lost woman; the Good Shepherd has taken her to Himself and clothed her with a new womanhood. A great fall is atoned for by a still greater repentance.
