BISHOP RICHARD RYAN ON THE HOLY NAME (1939): It is a Name of Divine power. See how soon after Our Lord's Ascension its power is shown. There are few incidents in the Apostolic annals more beautiful than the first public miracle after the descent of the Holy Ghost. It was worked, as you know, upon the lame man at the Beautiful Gate of the Temple by Peter and John. A poor cripple, who had been lame from his mother's womb, was carried as usual to the gate of the Temple to beg the charitable assistance of those who came to offer their prayers and sacrifices to the Lord. And seeing the two Apostles passing by, he humbly craved alms from them. But St. Peter, fixing his eyes upon him, immediately replied: "Silver and gold I have none, but what I have I give thee; in the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk." And taking him by the right hand, he lifted him up, and forthwith his feet and soles received strength. And he, leaping up, stood and walked.

It is certain that the Apostles did not claim this dominion over nature through any personal power; the miracle was worked in virtue of the Name of their Master. When the two Apostles were arrested and asked by what power or by what name they had done this, Peter, filled with the Holy Ghost, replied: "By the Name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, Whom you have crucified; even by Him that man stands before you whole."

This public triumph of that glorious Name was only the first of a long series of victories over earth and hell. It is the Name of countless battles and countless victories. It echoed of old through vaulted prisons and filled the heart of the confessor with courageous joy. It broke from the martyr's lips when nature could no longer suffer in silence, and it was oil poured out upon his wounds. It was the music of the anchorite when, in the depths of the desert, the powers of darkness broke loose upon him. So will it be for us if we learn to use that Sacred Name with reverence and confidence.
