APRIL 30-MAY 2—VISIT FROM OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE SEMINARY: The seminarians from Our Lady of Guadalupe Seminary in Denton, Nebraska, will be visiting Kansas City and our parish next weekend. On Friday, April 30, they will be arriving and chanting Vespers before the 6:00pm Mass. On Saturday, May 1, there will be a Solemn Mass at 9:00am with the seminarians providing ministers, servers, and music. We will also have Solemn Mass on Sunday, May 2, at 11:30am with the seminarians.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION: This year First Holy Communion will take place at the Masses on Sunday, May 16.

On Saturday, May 8, following the 9:00am Mass, there will be enrollment in the Brown Scapular for the first communicants. After the enrollment, the priests will interview the candidates for First Communion. Those who pass the interview will then be able to make their first confession immediately after the interview.

If your child would like to make their First Holy Communion, please ensure that your child knows the Ten Commandments, Seven Sacraments, and basic prayers such as the Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory be, and the Act of Contrition.

It is important that parents fill out the sacramental request form, especially noting the time of the Mass you will be attending. You must also have a baptism certificate sent to us from your child's parish of baptism.

MAY CROWNING & PROCESSION: Also on Sunday, May 16, the crowning of Our Lady and procession will take place before the 11:30am High Mass. The First Communicants will walk at the front of the procession with the young ladies sprinkling rose petals before Our Lady. The children should gather at the front of the church after the Vidi Aquam holy water sprinkling.
